ABOUT

The 12-bed B.E.A.C.H. unit provides a secure, structured therapeutic environment for short-term crisis resolution and psychiatric treatment for children and adolescents. In most instances, a length of stay of 3-5 days is sufficient to resolve the crisis, and connect the minor and their family to appropriate outpatient support.

Children and adolescents admitted to B.E.A.C.H. will be given a thorough psychiatric and behavioral assessment, along with subsequent medication treatment provided by a qualified child/adolescent psychiatric provider. An experienced treatment team supervised by a boardcertified psychiatrist and led by an advanced practice psychiatric nurse and a licensed clinical psychologist provide comprehensive treatment, including daily individual and group therapy, music and art therapy, and other skill-building groups. Parents are encouraged to actively participate in treatment.
