Apalachee Center, Inc. has served the Tallahassee community since 1948. In 1977, services were expanded to include the surrounding 7 counties, resulting in a service area that now spans across 5500 square miles. We serve approximately 6000 clients each year and employ over 400 individuals throughout our many facilities.

We are currently the largest community mental health center between Pensacola and Gainesville. We serve as intern/resident sites for both Florida State University and Florida Agricultural and Mechanical University in areas that include pharmacy, psychiatry, social work, nursing, and psychology.

ABOUT US

Apalachee Center Satellite Apartments is a Level IV residential facility designed to provide a homelike apartment setting that provides care, support and assistance with limited supervision, to adults diagnosed with a severe and persistent mental illness.

Our purpose is to help residents return to independent living in the community. Residents at this level have attained most of the skills required for independent living and require minimal staff support. Our program design empowers the lives of each and every participant, and is a stepping stone on the path to independent living.



ELIGIBILITY

All potential residents are screened by the Residential Services Supervisor, or designee, to determine if they are a candidate for admission to the program.

- Diagnosed as having a mental illness
- Age 18 or older
- Ambulatory or capable of self transfer
- Able to be an active participant in treatment and services offered
- Free of major medical conditions that require ongoing nursing care
- Able to self-medicate and monitor their own medications, maintain personal hygiene, participate in social interaction
- Manages income
- Procures food and other items necessary to maintain a household
- Prepares meals either individually or cooperatively
- Utilizes community transportation systems
- Free of any chronic inappropriate behavior which disrupts the facility's functioning, or is harmful to self or others
- Free of any criminal charge involving a sexual offense.
