In 1977, services were expanded to include the surrounding 7 counties, resulting in a service area that now spans across 5500 square miles. We serve approximately 6000 clients each year and employ over 500 individuals throughout our many facilities.

We are currently the largest community mental health center between Pensacola and Gainesville. We serve as intern/resident sites for both Florida State University and Florida Agricultural and Mechanical University in areas that include pharmacy, psychiatry, social work, nursing, and psychology.

## **ABOUT US**

Transition Home is a short-term residential treatment facility that serves 16 men and women who have been stepped-down or diverted from Civil State Hospitals. Our purpose is to bridge the gap between the hospital and community.

Residents live in a structured setting with one LPN and two Mental Health Assistants available 24/7. At Transition Home, residents have an opportunity for individualized community reintegration while developing independent living and relapse prevention skills.

The target length of stay for Transition Home residents is 6 to 9 months. Open communication between the resident and treatment team is essential for success in the program. We strive to make residents feel at home while planning for their discharge to more permanent placement.

## **ELIGIBILITY**

All potential residents are screened by the Residential Services Supervisor, or designee, to determine if they are a candidate for admission to the program.

- Diagnosed as having a mental illness
- Age 18+
- Ambulatory or capable of self transfer
- Able to participate in services
- Free of major medical conditions requiring ongoing care
- Potential to self-administer medication
- Maintains personal hygiene
- Free of any disruptive or harmful, chronic inappropriate behavior
- Free of any criminal charge involving a sexual offense
